



Banjo Brothers Saddlebag Panniers Instructions

(#01090)

Installation



1. The panniers come with a pair of dropout hooks (for bike racks without integral hooks). Attach as shown here if needed
2. Slip forward strap over the front of the rack to prevent the panniers from sliding back
3. Attach both the right and left lower straps. It is easiest to do this with the strap adjusted so that the hooks have slight tension on them.
4. Tighten the main buckle to secure both lower straps.

General comments

- The Saddlebag Panniers are made from waterproof fabric, but are **not** considered waterproof bags because the seams are not sealed. They will keep your stuff remarkably dry, but a bag's got to know its limits. A commute in some drizzle – probably fine. An all-day ride in a downpour – you will have some leaks. If waterproofness is a priority for you, we suggest our Waterproof Pannier (#01110) instead.
- The cinch strap and elastic are replaceable in the event of damage or loss of strength. Contact customer service or the bike shop where you purchased it.
- The maximum capacity is 30 pounds. They are ruggedly designed for daily commuting and recreational use, but not loaded touring. You don't have to baby them, but they weren't designed for epic multi-country tours.
- If they get dirty, hand wash them with soap and water and air dry. Otherwise, show off that patina that says "I ride my bike rain or shine". Do not put them in the dryer unless you want them to melt. Solvents can and will deteriorate the synthetic fibers. Sustained exposure to sunlight will also cause some fading and deterioration to all fabrics. We can't defeat the laws of chemistry and physics, but we do our best to resist them.
